P u r p o s e

The SPJST Fraternalist of the Year Award is an honor presented at the state level. The National Fraternal Congress (NFCA) makes an award at the national level. Both programs recognize an individual within our fraternal benefit system who, through example and accomplishment, provided outstanding volunteer service to his or her lodge, society and community **during the past year.**

E l i g i b i l i t y

- ◆ The nominee must be a member in good standing of a local lodge and must be living at the time of selection.
- ◆ SPJST Home Office Staff and other individuals compensated by the Society as employees are not eligible to receive the award.
- ◆ Nominees of age 16 or above are eligible.
- ◆ The SPJST Fraternalist of the Year can only be won once. However, a person is eligible to be a candidate again from their local lodge if they have been nominated and selected previously but have not won the SPJST Fraternalist of the Year

D e s c r i p t i o n o f t h e A w a r d s

The SPJST Fraternalist of the Year

- ◆ The honoree will be invited for award presentation to the 2009 SPJST Incentive Awards Banquet.
- ◆ One winner and four runners-up will be selected. There will be no ties.

The 2008 National Fraternalist of the Year

- ◆ The honoree will be invited for award presentation to the 123rd NFCA Annual Meeting in 2009. Travel, lodging and meal expenses for themselves and one guest will be paid for by the NFCA.
- ◆ The NFCA will present a check for \$1,000 in the name of the Fraternalist of the Year to the charitable/nonprofit organization of the honoree's choice.
- ◆ One winner and four runners-up will be selected. There will be no ties.

P r o g r a m P r o c e d u r e

The judging will be administered by an outside committee. SPJST officers and directors, Home Office Staff and sales representatives cannot serve as judges. The winner of the SPJST Fraternalist of the Year is then automatically entered in the NFCA Fraternalist of the Year contest.

Each lodge is encouraged to sponsor the program within their local lodge. It is suggested that the program within each lodge be coordinated and promoted by the fraternal activities coordinator.

Each lodge is eligible to submit one nomination of only one person per year. Please use the nomination form provided. **Information listed on the nomination form should cover activities for the past year only.**

The SPJST will distribute press information regarding the SPJST Fraternalist of the Year Award.

One original color photograph of the nominee (head & shoulders photo) must be included and will not be returned. A scanned photo of at least 300 dpi is acceptable. Failure to include a quality photograph with the nomination form represents an incomplete nomination and will result in disqualification.

All nomination forms must be postmarked by January 16, 2009.

Incomplete entries or entries postmarked after the deadline will not be considered.
